

Title: “Inno- Inclusive Talent”

Outline: “Design and development of innovative methodologies to reduce disparities in learning outcomes affecting students from disadvantaged backgrounds”

Target group:

Students from schools located in disadvantaged neighborhood, with social unrest and high level of non-EU immigration. The age range of the students is 15 to 17 years old (3rd and 4th level of compulsory of secondary school – in Spain and the equivalent on other countries).

Justification of the proposal:

Recent studies show a high potential in students living in a disadvantaged backgrounds. Such potential is not properly developed due to a lack of specific programs for these students.

Methodology

The combination of the following approaches,

- ✓ Lifelong learning, together with
- ✓ “learning by doing” techniques and
- ✓ Methods for gifted students,
- ✓ Participative sharing of experiences and
- ✓ Emotional coaching and the relationship with the teacher

Offer an interesting perspective to afford the challenges that the target group face.

Planned actions:

- 1) Diagnosis of “learning capacities” of the target group with a focus on “Gifted students”.
- 2) Benchmarking, exchange of good practices and design of an innovative and collaborative methodology to improve the learning outcome of the student.
- 3) Pilot project. In one selected centre from each region, the new methodology will be applied.
- 4) Monitoring and evaluation.
- 5) Policy recommendation. Based on the results of the evaluation specific recommendations on this file will be produced.
